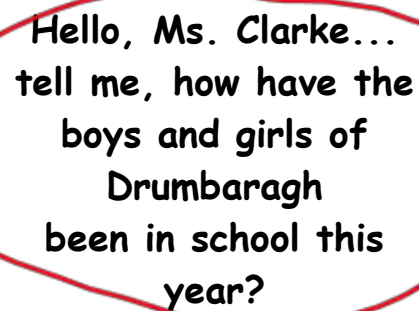

Drop Everything and Write!

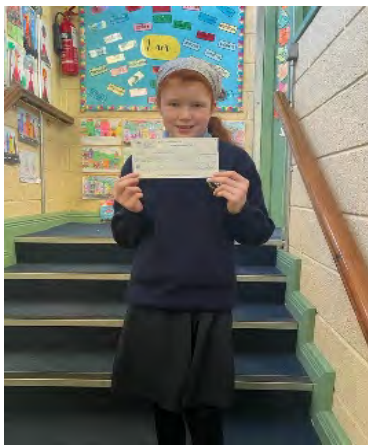


Our infants did amazing writing in class this term; some fabulous letters, cards, messages, shopping lists, and Santa lists were produced.
